



Fall 2010 Enrollment







Enrollment of First-Time Freshmen, Fall 2006-2010







Enrollment of First-Time Freshmen by Economic Development Region, Fall 2009-2010





Enrollment of Undergraduate Students by Classification and Gender, Fall 2010





Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, EAS Portal 2010





Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2010





Enrollment of Graduate Students by Classification and Gender, Fall 2010




