






Enrollment by College, Fall 2012


Enrollment by State/Country of Origin, Fall 2012

In Fall 2012, 76.9% of VSU Students are Enrolled Full-Time.




61.7% of VSU Students Enrolled in Fall 2012 are Female.

Undergraduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender





Undergraduate Enrollment by College





Graduate Enrollment by College






Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender

First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Enrollment, Fall 2008-Fall 2012





First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2012




Five Georgia Counties with the Highest First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Enrollment, Fall 2012
